
Trainees learned proper pruning and planting methods as well as what makes a hazard.





## Dumont Tree Ordinance:

In continuing the effort to protect the trees in our town, the Borough of Dumont has passed an amendment to the Shade Tree ordinance. A permit is now required before ANY tree greater than 6 inches in caliper or 10 feet in height can be removed within the Borough of Dumont. This ordinance applies to trees on private property and to town trees. Before any tree can be removed, the homeowner or contractor needs to get a permit from the Building Department.

There is a fee of \$25.00. Following the application for a permit, the Dumont Shade Tree Commission will inspect the tree to certify the jurisdiction of the tree and determine if the tree is on private property and therefore can proceed.

The application process will be completed within 5 days of the application request.

### PAVING THE WAY TO A GREENER DUMONT Buy a Brick



## Pine Cone Snowy Owl

You will need:

- $\Rightarrow$  1 Pine Cone
- ⇒ Enough cotton balls to fill
- $\Rightarrow$  2 googley eyes
- ⇒ white and brown pipe cleaners
- ⇒ Tacky glue

Stuff cotton balls into pine cone. Glue two googley eyes to top of pine cone. Fold two pieces of white pipe cleaners in half and glue to sides of pine cone for wings. Fold a small piece of brown pipe cleaner and glue between the googley eyes for the nose.


# Helpful tip to help your trees survive the winter

It's winter time— what you can expect from your trees? Deciduous trees lose their leaves but what can your trees expect from you?

Young trees have thin bark that can easily be damaged by animals such as deer and rodents and equipment like snow blowers. To prevent long-term damage to the trunk you can put plastic tubing or wire fencing with 1/4"-1/2" mesh squares around the trunk. The tube should be wide enough around to allow 1-4 inches of space between it and the

trunk. It should be 1-3 feet tall so it's higher than snow. Wrap the tube around the trunk, then secure the tube into the ground. Attach it to one or two stakes if necessary. Protection can be applied anytime and left on all year round, as long as it does not touch the bark. Trees grow from the outside out, so the tube will need to be enlarged and eventually removed.
